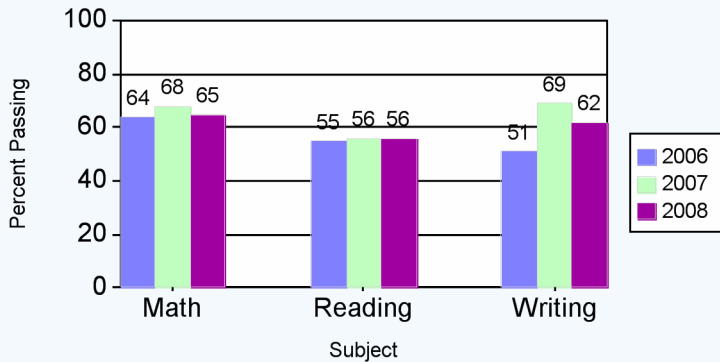
AZ LEARNS Profile For The School Underperforming

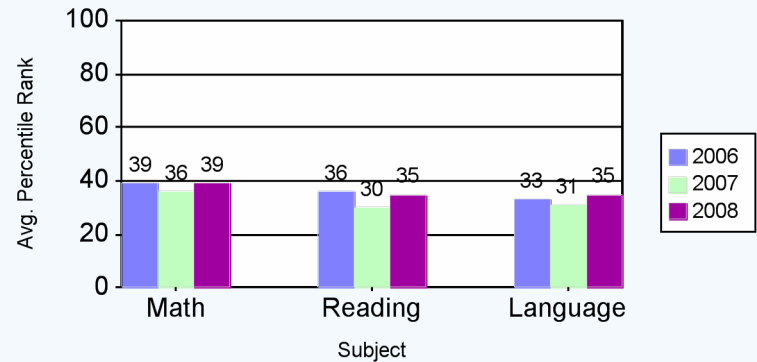
